☐ Designate a spokesperson/weather watcher.	☐ Provide workers with resources to develop a family communication plan for emergencies.
☐ Create a snow removal plan (who, when, how).	
☐ Consider shovel selection (lighter is better).	The rig
☐ Remove rooftop snow (if any)—identify access and fall protection measures.	<ul> <li>Inclement weather travel policy (method of communication, designated communicator)</li> </ul>
☐ Address drips and ice, specifically around entryways.	☐ Minimum safety requirements for vehicles
☐ Consider spreading ice melt for early arrivals.	$\square$ Inspection procedures and checklists
☐ Establish designated paths for inclement conditions and	☐ Emergency kit (establish required contents)
focus primary ice/snow control efforts on those areas.	☐ Clear windows and lights
☐ Ensure all designated pathways are well lit.	☐ Chaining up—policy and training
Use appropriate mats outside and inside of building at all main access/egress points. Remember, no gaps at doorways!	Resources SAIF: Slips, trips, and falls
